Progress Toward Degree Requirements

- obtain a grade of C or better in BIOL 1105, BIOL 1106, BIOL 1115 and BIOL 1116 (or equivalent) with no more than two (2) attempts including a Withdrawal (W) grade.
- obtain a grade of C or better in CHEM 1035 and CHEM 1036 (or equivalent) with no more than two (2) attempts including a Withdrawal (W) grade.
- obtain a grade of C or better in BIOL 2604 and BIOL 2614 with unlimited attempts allowed if I am pursuing a B.S. in Microbiology

2. Students who have exhausted their two (2) attempts at any of the following courses *will be dismissed from the major*: BIOL 1105, 1106, 1115, 1116, CHEM 1035, CHEM 1036 (or equivalents).
